# **Vendor Rules and Guidelines**

## (Updated May 2025)

The Peninsula Country Market strives to provide a vibrant, respectful, and safe community market for vendors and patrons alike. The following rules apply to all participating vendors and are subject to review and amendment by the Market Board as needed.

# **Field Conduct**

- Vendors are expected to be **cooperative**, **respectful**, **and courteous** to the Market Manager, volunteers, patrons, and fellow vendors at all times.
- The Market enforces a **ZERO tolerance policy** regarding aggressive behavior or foul language. Any vendor engaging in such behavior will be asked to leave immediately and may have their vending privileges suspended at the Market Manager's discretion.

#### Vendor Requirements & Regulations

- 1. "Local" is defined as Vancouver Island and the adjoining Gulf Islands.
- 2. Priority is given to vendors offering local produce, food products, and handmade crafts made from local materials.
- 3. Vendors must always have their contact information clearly visible for customers.
- Vendors wishing to sell produce from outside the local area but within B.C. must receive prior approval from the Market Manager. Input may be sought from other farmers before a decision is made.
- 5. The Market reserves the right to **regulate all products offered for sale** and their display. Final decisions rest with the Market Manager. Appeals may be submitted to the PCM Board using the form available on the PCM website.

### Food Safety & Packaging

6. All food vendors must comply with **Island Health food safety regulations**. Required permits and approvals must be available for inspection each market day.

- 7. To support sustainability, food vendors are required to use **commercially compostable** packaging, containers, and utensils.
- Vendors are responsible for their own waste and garbage. Large boxes and packaging must be taken home. Vendors must keep their space tidy and free of litter — including areas in front of their booth.

#### **Product Registration & Insurance**

- Vendors must register all intended sale items when applying. Additional products must be pre-approved by the Market Manager. Unregistered items may result in suspension of vending privileges.
- Vendors are encouraged (but not required) to carry liability insurance. Preferred rates are available through Duuo Insurance and Western Financial Group when mentioning the Peninsula Country Market.

#### Safety, Setup, and Attendance

- 11. All vendors must **secure tents/canopies/umbrellas** with proper weights or stakes on **each leg**. Unsecured setups will not be permitted.
- 12. Vendor **vehicles must be off the field by 8:45am** and not moved during market hours. Only one vehicle may be parked on the market field.
- 13. Vendors must supply their own **tables**, **tents**, **chairs**, and any other setup equipment. The Market does not rent out these items.
- 14. Vendors are **encouraged to leave pets at home**. If bringing a dog, it must be leashed and well-behaved.
- 15. **Market hours** are 9:00am–1:00pm. Vendors may arrive at 7:00am and must be fully set up by 8:45am. Vendors arriving after 8:30am may lose their assigned space. **Packing up early is not permitted**.

#### **Cancellations & Fees**

16. Vendors must notify the Market Manager by Thursday at 6:00pm if they need to cancel.

- Late cancellations (after Thursday but before 7:00am Saturday): \$10 fee payable at the next market.
- No-shows (no communication): \$30 fee payable at the next market.

#### 17. 2025 Fees:

- Annual Membership: \$40
- Single Market Space: \$30
- Additional Space (if available): \$25
   The Market Manager will collect payment during each market in cash or cheque. Receipts will be provided.

# **Closures & Emergencies**

18. In the event of **severe weather or other emergencies**, the Market Manager may declare the market closed. Vendors must **cease operations and vacate** immediately when this occurs.
